



Board, Training and Lessons

- \$725** **Condition training - price includes Cost of Care Board**
 Finished show horses in need of conditioning for light to moderate showing -performance or in-hand.
- \$800** **Finish Training - price includes Cost of Care Board**
 Horses in need of extensive conditioning, ground schooling, start and/or finish training under saddle or in harness, or rehabilitating of behavioral and/or performance problems both in-hand or under saddle.
- \$425** **Board Only**
This option is depending on space availability and individual needs, at the sole discretion of Winfield Farm & Forge.
- \$200 – Evaluation** One week of intense evaluation of your horse to determine an appropriate program. Includes all cost of care.
- \$25 – ½ hour** **Lessons- please see our lesson information sheet for more details and schedule.**
\$50 – hour

Horse Show Fees

- \$50 One Day Local Show** -Any show that the round trip travel and the entire show bill are completed on the same day. Transportation included.
- \$35 ½ Day Local Show** -Any show that the round trip travel and the entire show bill are completed on the same day. Covers clients only entering ONE class per show day. Can also be charged for horses not staying on show grounds for a full show day before, after, or during the show, but ONLY for Local shows. Transportation included.

Class A Arabian show fees will be a combination of the following costs based on each individual show. These fees will remain the same regardless of distance or level of competition at the Class A level.

- 1. Transportation -** \$.50 per mile round trip from farm to show and back to farm. This will be determined based on the chosen route taken by GPS or other mapping systems.
- 2. Day Fee –** This covers the cost of having trainer on site for show and responsible for your animal, including any practice sessions needed for horse/rider. This includes all set up and tear down days. This fee covers the use of all farm property while at a show such as but not limited to, grooming supplies, farm equipment wear and tear, trainer accommodations and expenses. Clients must choose one rate for an entire show.
- \$20 per day –** Client helps with the daily upkeep of all horses and stall area while at show. Junior riders will be expected to help in the daily care of all animals and stall area as needed while at the show. This is an integral part of the horsemanship learning process and a foundation of our philosophies here at Winfield Farm & Forge. We do not have paid grooms and in order to keep that cost down, we work as a team.

Fee Schedule – con't Horse Show Fees

\$50 per day - This rate is for absentee owners, clients who choose not to or are unable to participate in the overall functioning of the barn team while at the show. Client may care for their own horse but it is not required at this rate.

3. Class Fee – Covers warm up before class, coaching of rider or trainer presenting horse. There will be no additional fees to coach or show back a horse in a Championship that doesn't require an additional entry fee. No fee if trainer is not available to coach or is showing a different horse in the same class as a client.

\$10 per class - All In Hand classes

\$20 per class - All Under Saddle classes

\$50 per class - All Driving classes

4. Braiding fee – Mane/Forelock OR Tail = \$20 per show
Mane/Forelock/Tail = \$40 per show
This fee covers cost of supplies and time needed to braid.

*Day fees for all shows are charged per horse.

*Two or more riders/handlers per one horse – class fees *charged per horse and rider/handler* combo.

*Trainer reserves the right to limit or adjust number of classes horse is entered per day based on animal's health and welfare.

*Two or more horses/client – all fees *charged per HORSE*.

* If a client is using a Winfield-owned horse to show, they will still be charged the regular show fee rates to accommodate the care and prep of that horse.

*Fees do not include ANY costs directly charged by individual show (EX. - entries, stall rental, show office fees, non-member fees)

*Split costs –They include but are not limited to tack rooms, grooming stalls, bedding and feed purchased at show, patronships. This will be billed per show.

*No horse or rider will show with an account 30 days past due.

Horse Show Credit Program

We now allow the earning of credit towards *horse show day fees and coaching fees*. This credit may not be applied to any other expenses incurred from Winfield Farm billing, such as board bills or the like. Client must work at horse shows in which they are not entered or showing in order to earn credits towards another show in which they wish to compete. Clients will be responsible for hotel and some food expenses at non competing shows. This fee will be predetermined for each individual show as it is booked.

One day of work at non competing show = \$25 dollars credit towards the next competing show to be used for horse show day fees and coaching fees.

For example – Work a three day show with arrival one day before = four days of work, earn \$100 towards the bill for your next entered horse show. This can only be redeemed for horse show day fees and coaching fees. All other billed expenses must be paid in full.
